Ferguson Youth Initiative to Host “Party with a Purpose” on November 20

FERGUSON, Mo., Nov. 10 – The Ferguson Youth Initiative (FYI) and the Ferguson Youth Advisory Board are hosting a “Party With A Purpose (PWAP)” on November 20th, 2015 for teens 13-19 years old. The event, which will be held at Ferguson Middle School, located at 701 January in Ferguson, will provide an opportunity for those attending to participate in number of fun activities as well as speak on the impact the organization has had on Ferguson teens since its inception in 2010.



PWAP organizers hope the event’s environment, which features survey activities along a maze as well as opportunities for teens to discuss specific priorities that FYI should focus on in the near future, will foster dialogue leading to specific action items.

The format was designed by teen leaders of the youth advisory board that wanted PWAP to not only be teen focused and fun, but intertwined with a purpose where important issues can be openly discussed. The event will feature giveaways, food and teen performances during the party.
